



BAD BEAT JACKPOT RULES AND PLAYER ADVICE

The Bad Beat Jackpot will be offered on all House Dealer Dealt Texas Hold'em Cash Games*

All players taking part in House Dealer Dealt Texas Hold'em Cash Games are

eligible to win the Bad Beat Jackpot.

The Bad Beat Jackpot will increase daily and a notice will be posted advertising the current amount available.

The dealer shall retain £1 from each eligible pot.**

An eligible pot is defined as;

- Hand must see a flop
- Pot must be £25 minimum before rake is extracted
- Hand must be dealt by house dealer
- Jackpot only offered on Texas Hold'em Cash Games

To win the Bad Beat Jackpot a player must be beaten at showdown (show of cards

to determine winner of pot) whilst holding the minimum qualifying hand.

The minimum (lowest ranked) hand to qualify for Jackpot is Full House, Aces full of Jacks

A A A K K

Both the player holding the Bad Beat Hand and the player holding the best hand (winner of the pot at showdown) must use both hole cards in the construction of their hands, a maximum of three community cards (flop, turn and river) can be used.

A minimum of four players must take part (receive cards) in the Jackpot hand

All players will be required to produce ID to receive payment***

Jackpot is paid out / distributed in the following way:****

1st Prize 50% to Bad Beat Hand

2nd Prize 25% to best hand (winner of the pot at showdown)

3rd Prize 20% distributed equally to remaining players partaking (received cards) in

the Jackpot hand (player must be playing on table where Jackpot hand is dealt)

4th Prize 5% distributed equally to all other players partaking in Bad Beat cash

games at time of Jackpot (player must be playing in cardroom where Jackpot hand is dealt)

In the event of two or more tied hands being simultaneously declared as Jackpot winners each prize (1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th) will be split equally between each eligible player.

In the event that a table has two or more hands that qualify for the Jackpot, e.g. two players with quads beaten by a straight flush, the first prize is split equally.

*Bad Beat Jackpot is not offered on any tournaments, Omaha, Stud, dealer's choice, round of each etc.

**50% of Bad Beat rake contributed to current Jackpot

15% of Bad Beat rake is retained by the casino as an administration fee.

The balance of the daily Bad Beat rake will contribute towards the reserve (the next) jackpot and/or towards other prizes for the benefit of card room players from time to time as may be determined at the sole discretion of the casino

***If player is not a Player Rewards Card holder the casino will withhold payment until the player has produced satisfactory ID (e.g. passport, photo driving licence).

****The Company reserve the right to withhold immediate payment of any jackpot to enable the probity of the win to be satisfied.

Management may vary the rules or discontinue the Bad Beat promotion at any time by displaying a notice to that effect
